The DELF and DALF are **official qualifications awarded by the French Ministry of Education** to certify the competency of candidates from outside France in the French language.

The candidates should be at least 16 years-old.

The DELF and DALF are composed of 6 independent diplomas that correspond to the levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

At each level all 4 competences are being tested: reading, writing, listening and speaking, with varying degrees of interaction and mediation required depending on the level.

The DELF et le DALF are valid everywhere, they benefit from the recognition enjoyed by all official qualifications awarded by the French Ministry of Education. They are valid for life.

If you are not French and would like **your French skills to be recognized** for personal or professional purposes, you can take DELF and/or DALF. The DELF and DALF diplomas are independent, so you can take the examination of your choice. You can also sit the examinations for a number of diplomas during the same examination session.

If you are a non-French-speaking French person, you may obtain authorization from the National Commission for DELF and DALF to take the DELF examinations.

REGISTRATION

On site:

by going to the Exams department – Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays, 9am to 4:30pm – building B, room 430

By mail:

by downloading the registration form on our web site: www.alliancefr.org and sending it by regular mail.

The form should be sent at least the day before the registration deadline (postal acceptance rule applies), filled and attached with:

- registration fees (payment by check or credit card)
- 2 envelopes (A4 format, 1 must be hard-back) addressed to yourself with your address for Attestation and Diploma to be sent, pre-stamped at proper rate (50 to 100 grams, to France or abroad).

No registration online or by fax.

For these exams, no reimbursement can be done; solely a report for professional or medical reason may be required by the candidate, at least 15 days before the exam.

Registration will be taken into account only if fully completed: form, envelop with address and stamp, payment.

NOTIFICATION

Important: you must come on the day of the exam with an ID.

RESULT, ATTESTATION AND DIPLOMA

The results are posted at the Alliance française Paris Ile-de-France and will be soon available on our web site.

The President of the jury issues an '*Attestation de réussite provisoire*'. Issued only once, it is valid in France and abroad.

The diploma is issued by the Rectorat of the Paris Academy within the following months.

Attention: some delay is required to issue the diplomas; you should give us a permanent address and let us know about any address change.
